

School Conditions of Hire

Numbers: A minimum of 35 guests is required for all group bookings for Peppers and Gums Campsites.

Catering:

- * Self catering is permitted on site. If a booking requires catering contacts are available
- * Health and safety regulations must be adhered to

What to bring:

- * Your own towel, fitted sheet, bedding/sleeping bag and pillow.
- * First Aid Kit and trained First Aider.
- * Cleaning materials - detergents, disinfectants, tea towels etc.
- * Sporting equipment - tennis racquets, footballs, soccer balls, cricket gear.

What NOT to bring:

- * PETS - no pets of any kind are permitted on site.
- * Roller blades, scooters, skate boards; or similar are not permitted on site.
- * ALCOHOL - alcohol is not permitted on site.

On Arrival: Please report to Office/Management for briefing and access to keys

Check In time: Incoming guests are able to arrive after 2pm

Parking

Cars must be parked in allocated areas only.

Caravans

Maximum of SIX caravans permitted in individual allocated areas only. NO TENTS of any type or size permitted on site.

PLEASE NOTE: From 1 July 2011 Caravans will not be permitted on site under any circumstance.

- * Supervision of children is required at all times.
- * It is recommended that children under 9 years of age sleep on a bottom bunk.
- * Camp leaders are responsible for supervision of their group at all times.
- * SMOKING is not allowed in any building. Please extinguish butts and place in pits provided.
- * NOISE is to be kept to a minimum between the hours of 10pm and 8am.
- * FIRES are not permitted on site or on the beach.
- * BOATS - NO hosing down or washing of boats or flushing of boat engines permitted on site.
- * All food scraps to be placed in rubbish bins. No food to be left out for native animals.
- * Clotheslines are provided and are to be used for all washing. Temporary clotheslines are not permitted.

Emergency Procedures:

Emergency procedure notices are placed around the campsite. Fire hydrants, extinguishers, smoke alarms and hoses are located around the site. Familiarise yourself with this and ensure that you have an emergency procedure that your group understands. Fire equipment is not to be tampered with or used in any circumstance other than for emergency fire fighting purposes.

On Departure:

The camp leader is responsible to ensure their group leaves the site in a clean and tidy condition.

All guests are required to clean the facilities prior to departure.

The camp leader and Manager will inspect the camp (1/2 hour) before your group leaves and any failure to adequately clean will incur a cleaning fee.

Damage to any property & equipment will be invoiced to your group.

A minimum fee of \$80 will be charged for any graffiti regardless of the type or size of the discretion.

Check Out time: Outgoing guests are required to vacate premises by 10am.

Late Checkout: Arrangements for late checkout may be available upon request. A late fee may apply.

- * Management reserves the right to ask any person who does not abide by the rules of the camp to leave the property.
- * Any conduct inconsistent with the Baptist Churches of WA beliefs and purposes will be deemed unacceptable behaviour.
